POULTRY CLASS LIST

1. **All exhibitors must be pre-registered.** All food animal exhibitors need to have completed the Show Me Quality Assurance to be eligible to show. All advance registrations must be mailed by Friday, June 28, 2019 to Brandon Panhorst at 116 Gray Squirrel Trl Berger MO 63014.
2. Poultry must be in place by the designated time on the day of the show. They will be released between 7:30 and 10:00pm on the evening of the show. The exact time will be determined by the Livestock Committee and announced that evening. **No haul-out trailers during the show. Premiums will be forfeited if exhibits are removed before the release time, or if stall area is not cleaned. Any animal deemed unmanageable by the Livestock Committee before, during, or after the show will be required to leave the grounds.**
3. The New Haven Youth Fair Livestock shows are open to anyone up to 18 years old.
4. Animals exhibited must be owned and shown by the exhibitor. If an exhibitor has more than one exhibit in a class, the exhibitor may recruit another youth exhibitor to show one of the animals.
5. Bedding for livestock must be provided by the exhibitor.
6. Livestock exhibitors must use Livestock Entry Form.
7. A stall fee of \$1.00 per animal for poultry must accompany advanced registration. Pen classes will be considered as one entry. Stall fee may be paid in cash or check. **Checks are payable to the New Haven Youth Fair.**
8. No trophy will be given unless there are two or more animals within a breed.
9. Showmanship trophies will be awarded in the age divisions below:
 - a. Junior Showmanship – Up to 10 years as of Jan. 1, 2019
 - b. Intermediate Showmanship – age 11-14 as of Jan. 1, 2019
 - c. Senior Showmanship – age 15-18 as of Jan. 1, 2019
 - d. Must be 2 exhibitors before trophy is awarded.

ANIMAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

OFFICIAL FAIR VETERINARIAN – HERMANN VET CLINIC

Please contact your veterinarian if you have questions.

- A. Poultry must have no signs of contagious or infectious disease. Poultry must have a VS Form 9-2 (or similar certificate) showing a negative Pullorum – Typhoid test within the past ninety (90) days to exhibition or originate from a flock approved by the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP). Waterfowl are exempt from this testing requirement. A representative of the department shall have access to the event and may inspect or test poultry as considered necessary.
- B. All birds must be free of disease or parasites. Animals exhibiting parasites or disease will not be placed in the tent, and will be disqualified from the show.
- C. Poultry exhibits are to be pre-registered on livestock entry form. An exhibitor may enter a total of 20 exhibits in the Poultry Show.

- 121 – Old Pen (2 hens, 1 rooster) over 1 year
- 122 – Young Pen (2 pullets, 1 cockerel) under 1 year
- 123 – Single Rooster, over 1 year
- 124 – Single Hen, over 1 year
- 125 – Single Cockerel, under 1 year
- 126 – Single Pullet, under 1 year

CHICKENS – Fancy

- 127 – Old Pen (2 hens, 1 rooster) over 1 year
- 128 – Young Pen (2 pullets, 1 cockerel) under 1 year
- 129 – Single Rooster, over 1 year
- 130 – Single Hen, over 1 year
- 131 – Single Cockerel, under 1 year
- 132 – Single Pullet, under 1 year

TURKEYS – No more than 4

- 200 – Adult Tom
- 201 – Young Tom
- 202 – Adult Hen
- 203 – Young Hen

WATER FOWL – No more than 8

- 204 – Adult Male
- 205 – Young Male
- 206 – Adult Female
- 207 – Young Female

SMALL BIRDS – No more than 4
