GENERAL RULES FOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

1. **All exhibitors must be pre-registered.** All food animal exhibitors need to have completed the Show Me Quality Assurance to be eligible to show. All advance registrations must be mailed by Friday, June 24, to Alex Meyer at 3139 Highway Y New Haven MO 63068
2. Sheep and Goats must be in place by the designated time on the day of the show. They will be released between 7:30 and 10:00pm on the evening of the show. The exact time will be determined by the Livestock Committee and announced that evening. **No haul-out trailers during the show.**
3. Swine, Beef, and Dairy Cattle must be in place by the designated time on the day of the show. They will be released as soon as possible after the show, with the exact time to be determined by the Livestock Committee. Stall area must be cleaned before animals are removed from the fair grounds. **Premiums will be forfeited if exhibits are removed before the release time, or if stall area is not cleaned. Any animal deemed unmanageable by the Livestock Committee before, during, or after the show will be required to leave the grounds.**
4. Read health requirements.
5. The New Haven Youth Fair Livestock shows are open to anyone up to 18 years old.
6. Animals exhibited must be owned and shown by the exhibitor. If an exhibitor has more than one exhibit in a class, the exhibitor may recruit another youth exhibitor to show one of the animals.
7. Bedding for livestock must be provided by the exhibitor.
8. Judging will be based on the Danish System; all exhibits will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon. Prize money will be awarded based on the ribbon received.
9. Livestock exhibitors must use Livestock Entry Form.
10. Exhibitors will be limited to two entries per single animal class and one entry per group class.
11. A stall fee of \$5.00 per animal for beef, dairy, sheep, goats, swine. Rabbit stall fee \$3 per animal. Stall fee may be paid in cash or check. **Checks are payable to the New Haven Youth Fair.**
12. No trophy will be given unless there are two or more animals within a breed.
13. Showmanship trophies will be awarded in the age divisions below for Beef, Swine, Sheep/Goat. Contestants must exhibit animals on their own.
 - a. Youth Showmanship – Contestants must exhibit animals on their own. – Up to 10 years as of Jan. 1, 2022
 - b. Intermediate Showmanship – age 11-14 as of Jan. 1, 2022
 - c. Senior Showmanship – age 15-18 as of Jan. 1, 2022
 - d. Must be 2 exhibitors before trophy is awarded.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES / GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- A. All animals must have a health certificate unless specifically exempted. The health certificate must show required tests, vaccinations, etc., and individual identification and description of animals. Health certificates are valid for thirty (30) days.
- B. Animals with ringworm lesions or easily visible warts will not exhibit and will have to be removed from community holding areas and stalls since these are contagious conditions
- C. The following listed entry requirements on livestock are for exhibition only. These minimal health and testing requirements do not qualify livestock that are to be sold or moved to a new owner or destination. Please investigate and comply with the added requirements for livestock that are to be in a safe as well as in an exhibition.

EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR CATTLE IN MO

- A. Intrastate (cattle in Missouri moving for exhibition only in Missouri, no health certificate required).
 1. Brucellosis: No test or vaccination is required.
 2. Tuberculosis: Tuberculosis tests are not required in MO cattle
 3. Scabies (mangs): Cattle originating in scabies-quarantined areas or herds are not eligible to exhibit.

1. Exhibitors may be no older than 12 as of Jan 1, 2022.
2. The calf may be dairy, beef or cross, heifer, steer or bull.
3. The class is limited to one calf per exhibitor.
4. Calf must be born between Jan 1, 2022 and April 1, 2022.
5. Entries must be shown by halter.
6. Each class winner will receive a trophy.
7. The class will be judged on the following criteria:
 - 25 points Presentation on the calf in the show ring
 - 20 points Condition and health of the calf
 - 5 points Quality of the calf
 - 50 points Judge's interview: member's knowledge, feeding and care of the calf.

Intrastate (Swine in Missouri moving for exhibition only in Missouri) – No certificate of veterinary inspection is required.

1. BRUCELLOSIS: No test is required
2. PSEUDORABIES: No test is required

EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR GOATS

A. Intrastate (Goats in Missouri exhibited in Missouri)

1. Goats that are to be exhibited must be free of clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease.
2. Goats (except castrated males) must be identified to flock of origin using official ID (ear tags or tattoos) and listed on a health certificate.

EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR SHEEP

A. Intrastate (Sheep in Missouri exhibited in Missouri)

1. Sheep that are to be exhibited must be free of clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease.
2. Sheep (except castrated males) must be identified to flock of origin using official ID (ear tags or tattoos) and listed on a health certificate.

3. Scabies

- a. Sheep from a scabies quarantined area must be dipped or treated by an officially approved method within ten (10) days prior to exhibition.
- b. A prior permit number must be obtained and recorded on a health certificate if the sheep are from a scabies quarantined area.

EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR RABBITS

Rabbit entries are to be pre-registered on livestock entry form. Limit one exhibit in Doe and Litter and Pen classes, and two exhibits in other classes. Members exhibiting in the Pet class are limited to two exhibits in the class, and no more than four exhibits for the show. All other exhibitors are limited to 16 exhibits for the show. Rabbits shown in the Pet class may not be shown in any other class. Rabbits shown in the Market Pen class may not be shown in classes 85-95. Rabbits shown in the Doe and Litter class may not be exhibited in any other class. Rabbits must be placed one hour before show time. Exhibitors must arrange to have cages at least six inches off the ground.

1. Animals will be checked for visible signs of parasites and disease before they are unloaded from the exhibitor’s vehicle.
